ImPACT Baseline Testing – What You Should Know



ImPACT™ is a computer-based test developed to evaluate cognitive recovery following a concussion. Individuals ten years old and over take an assessment test to establish their baseline functioning. When a head injury has occurred, the test is taken again for comparison to use as a tool in concussion management.

Did you know?

- ImPACT's baseline test should be taken **before** an injury occurs.
- ImPACT measures verbal and visual memory, processing, speed and reaction time.
- To ensure your child performs at his/her personal best, have your child sleep eight or more hours prior to testing and administer any medications he/she would take on a regular school day.
- Remember that baseline test results are only meaningful when analyzed in comparison to test results performed after a concussion/injury has occurred.
- Baseline ImPACT testing should be performed every two years.
